The common denominator is problem-solving.

Sacred Wagon personnel are expected to be comfortable with uncertainty, protect sensitive information, communicate clearly, document their work, and remain professional when circumstances become difficult.

The goal is not to create drama.

The goal is to **understand the problem, establish the facts, reduce uncertainty, and help determine what happens next.**

STRATEGIC INTELLIGENCE CONSULTANT

What the Job Is:

Strategic Intelligence Consultants help clients understand complicated situations and make informed decisions. They look beyond the immediate problem to identify risks, opportunities, relationships, and possible outcomes.
